Rosedale Grandmont Baseball League Volunteer Categories

Manager: Take principal responsibility for a team

Coach: Assist the manager

Field Maintenance: Mainly help set or return bases and chalk baselines prior to games. Assist in the maintenance of the diamonds/grounds

Fundraising: Assist in creating and implementing fundraising activities for your team or the league

Pancake Breakfast: (7 a.m.-noon, April 26) Set up, serve, and/or clean up Opening Day Pancake Breakfast

Picture Day: Assist Coach in organizing players on picture day, distribute team pictures

Publicity: Help publicize the league through community partnerships, communication in schools, and updated signage

Team Liaison: Communicate with coach about team family responsibilities and league announcements. Organize and communicate league information and family responsibilities to team families: snacks, practice schedules, equipment, field preparation/cleanup, health and safety
